Water borne diseases		State of river visually assessed for any obvious pollution risk. Students to wash hands afterwards.			P, CS, SS
Steep slopes of bunds at Prospect Farm		No running or rolling down the slopes - the bunds are covered in grasscrete - hard, uneven surface.			P
Falling in river (cold and wet)		Rivers are shallow so total immersion very unlikely. Wet individual in assessed to see if he or she can continue or otherwise needs to return to the centre. (see wet and cold generic RA)			P
Falling in river (injury)		Sections of river chosen are fairly easily accessible with flat, even of soft surfaces. Safety brief given to students			P
Road crossing (Victoria Avenue) Road crossing (Kings Road West)		Clearly communicated and supervised group crossing.			P
Road section (fire station to railway bridge - Northbrook Road)		Warning: no pavement here! Safety brief, single file and supervised.			P
Hazards on beach		See risk assessment for Swanage beach			P
Injury from ranging poles		Remind students that ranging poles aren't javelins. They need to be carried point down and sensibly.			P, CS, SS public
